Miliya rumarragun wirriya yangarrngaran ngangayi liyan jarrayirr yanggibardu yanggi yingarrjin.


We are proud of our yawuru language as we welcome and feel a new day dawning.



Shinju Matsuri is a testament to the history of pearling, the vibrant essence of our community, and the tapestry of cultures that define our town.



The People's Choice Award vote will be open during the exhibition, and will be announced at the Festival Finale on Sunday September 1st at Town Beach.








